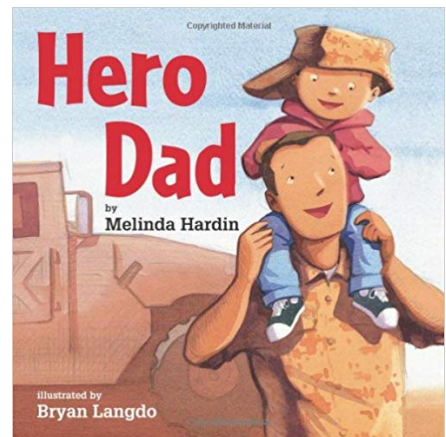

These guided discussion questions are designed to be used with children from ages 3-6 at home or in preschool settings. These questions can be used with children who have a loved one in the military or children who want to gain a better understanding of military life.

1. What is a hero? Do you know any heroes?
2. Why is the dad in the book called a hero?
3. Where might the dad be going when he goes on long trips?
4. The dad in the book drives a tank. What does your dad/grandpa/uncle/etc. drive?
5. What is a soldier? Do you know any soldiers or people in the military?
6. What is the neatest thing the dad in this story does? What is something neat that your dad/grandpa/uncle/etc. does?
7. What does your dad/grandpa/uncle/etc. do to show you how much he loves you?
