- 4. Have you ever had to say goodbye to someone you love? Were they gone for a long or short time? How did that make you feel?
- 5. What do you like to do to make the people you love happy?



- 6. How does Lily's mom help her feel better when she gets mad? How does she help her when she feels stubborn?
- 7. What is the first thing you do when you see the person you love if they have been gone for a long time?
