These guided discussion questions are designed to be used with children from ages 3-6 at home or in preschool settings. These questions can be used with children who have a loved one in the military or children who want to gain a better understanding of military life.

1. A friend is someone you know well and like very much.
Who do you know well and like very much?
2. Tell me about one of your friends and the fun things you like to do together.
3. Moses had a school assignment he needed to think about. Tell me about a time when you had to think about a project or questions before you could respond.
4. The class in the book sometimes gets noisy. When things are loud or noisy around you, what do you do to focus?
5. You can have friends who are different than and similar to you. How are you and your friends alike? How are you different?
6. The book describes ways everyone is unique or special. What makes you special?
7. The book describes how Hashi and Zaki had to learn new ways to climb and it was hard. Tell me about something you had a hard time learning to do.
8. Moses is lucky to have so many friends. What do you think makes a good friend?
