1. What are some things the family does for fun in this book?

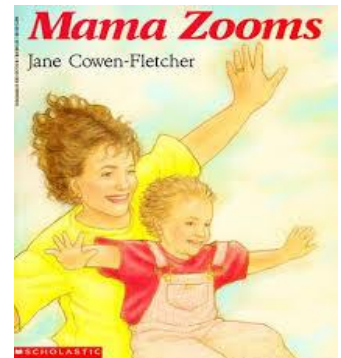
Invite the child to describe a time that they had fun exploring with their family or friends.

2. Who do you know someone who uses a wheelchair? Talk about some reasons why people might use a wheelchair.

3. Point out that people who use wheelchairs can do lots of things on their own. What are some things the mom in the book did on her own?

4. Ask the child to share two things that makes them unique and special.

5. Share your own experiences of how you and the child may be different and how you may be alike.
